


SUBMISSION INVITATION

- **Eligibility:** Open to artists of all ages and backgrounds, with a preference for those residing in or connected to the Gateway Region.
- Be sure to include:
- 1. Your proposal for a new piece. Works should cost no more than \$100 per piece to reproduce.
- Photos/digital files of your vision or concept for your proposed piece, along with a brief description.
- 3. A PDF or link to your portfolio/work samples.
 Please include the title, medium, dimensions, and a brief description of each piece.
- 4. Your artist statement and bio.

- **Media:** All forms of visual media will be considered, including painting, sculpture, photography, digital art, craft, mixed media, and more.
- **Theme:** Submissions should reflect the unique essence of the Gateway Region—its historical significance, cultural diversity, natural beauty, and contemporary life, with an eye towards the area's rich economic history.
